

Our Two Campuses


- » Our two campuses in **Mosbach** and **Bad Mergentheim** are located in small, safe towns with wonderful **medieval city centers**.



Courses for International Exchange Students

- » We offer **five different options** for exchange students throughout the year
- » Our **International Programs (IPB and IPE)** are taught in English
- » The program **GLACIP** offers intensive German language training



Courses for International Exchange Students

It includes a **ready-made set of courses, events and excursions** as well as **housing on one of our two campuses**.

GLACIP

GLACIP = German Language and Culture Immersion Program

- » GLACIP includes **intensive German language training and German culture classes**
- » The **3-months program** takes place from early January until late March
- » Classes take place in an **actual German castle** on our campus in Bad Mergentheim
- » The program includes **excursions in the region and other events**
- » You can apply if you have some German language skills (advanced beginner's level = German language knowledge equivalent to approx. 60 - 80 hours workload; A1.1, according to CEFR)

International Programs

- » We offer two different programs taught in English: **The International Program in Business** (IPB) and the **International Program in Engineering** (IPE)
- » You can earn up to **30 ECTS** in three-months program, each program contains a ready-made set of courses, so there is no hassle of trying to get into the different courses, no add and drop etc.
- » International students participate in an Intensive German language course prior to academic classes
- » Classes are taught entirely **in English**

International Programs

- » There is an **intercultural mix of students** in class, since both international and DHBW Mosbach students will be attending
- » We keep the class size small: you get to know everyone very well and be one **tight group** during your stay here.




Housing


